David and Goliath part 2

I Samuel 17:20- 18:4

When David arrived, both armies were running out shouting a battle cry as they faced off in the valley. There they were army against army facing each other. David left his food and ran down to the army and found his brothers and greeted them. As he talked with his brothers, here came the Giant from the city of Gath --- Goliath! Goliath hollered again to the Israelites the same words he's been saying every day. David heard those words and was shocked as he watched the Israelite army run away-- afraid! The soldiers told David, "Have you seen this man? When he came to challenge us, we were told that the man who kills him, will be given lots of money by the King and he will even allow him to marry his own daughter so he will become part of the King's family AND give them his own house (and he won't even have to pay any taxes!!)". David asked, "What will be done for the man who kills this Philistine and removes the bad reputation this giant is giving to Israel!? Who IS this ungodly man that he should dare to challenge the armies of the Living God!!?"
